INTRODUCTION

PREREQUISITES

- There are no formal entry requirements for this course.
- The minimum age to attend this course must be 14 years. Children below the age of 14 years are invited to follow the Three Cross Award.

INSTRUCTORS

This course is delivered by qualified and experienced trainers.

DURATION

The First Aid course may be delivered over 9 sessions lasting approximately 2 hours or 3 to 4 full days (depending on number of participants).

ASSESSMENT

The First Aid course is assessed through a written multiple choice test and a practical test.

CERTIFICATE

- An internationally recognised certificate with a 3-year validity is provided.
- The St John Ambulance First Aid certificate fulfils the obligations of the local Occupational Health & Safety Legislation.

FEE*

The minimum fee for a First Aid course is €420.00 for up to 12 participants. Additional participants can be added at a fee of €35.00 per person.
